- Market is OPEN Rain or Shine! No refunds due to weather or other conditions.
- Vendor must offer for sale any of the following: edible grains, fruits, seeds, forage, vegetables, live plants, trees, shrubs, perishable flowers, syrups, honey sorghum, baked goods, jams, jellies or other general farm products, per Ohio Department of Agriculture Farmer's Market Rules.
- Vendors with children accompanying their booth will make sure the children stay at their booth and not be running around bothering customers.
- Each vendor is responsible for obtaining & maintaining any & all licenses and permits. Downtown Lima, Inc. provides the Itinerant Dealer License to sell at the Farmer's Market, but each vendor is responsible for their own permits from the Allen County Health Department.

- Each vendor is responsible for all sales taxes that are applicable.
